Please find Written and Historic Testimony Attached for Hearing on Docket #0722 September 22, 2022 -Comprehensive Boston Harbor and Waterfront Plan:

1991 Municipal Harbor Plan is Expired and Obsolete Requiring a New and Comprehensive Boston Harbor Plan

In 2004 it was argued to be illegal for the BRA to base any new, non- Ch. 91 compliant, Harbor Master Plan on an un-renewed and expired 1991 Municipal Harbor Plan (A position taken by the BRA itself in 2000 with LDA developers during that bankruptcy). However, that is what was done in 2004 as some of the letters from that time to the MEPA / EOEa explain:

It is imperative to prepare a truly Comprehensive Plan of the Boston Harbor, with a focus on linking of harbor-front communities, to completely replace the 1991 MHP which is: 1. over a quarter of a century old 2. long ago expired, 3. factually and practically obsolete — and 4. NOT a *Comprehensive* Master Plan.:

The Supreme Judicial Court findings for the 2022 CLF case re the Downtown MHP applies to the entire Boston Harbor, especially the Charlestown MHP:
